- ◆ SIMPLIFY FILING A CLAIM - Fire Preparedness includes a well documented home inventory
- ◆ SUBSTANTIATE YOUR INVENTORY CLAIM TO CREATE A CLEAR FINANCIAL LOSS - The Insurance Information Institute 2021 website says you must have clearly substantiated evidence for tax break OR disaster assistance.
- ◆ HELPS YOU PURCHASE RIGHT AMOUNT OF INSURANCE IN THE FIRST PLACE.



HOME INVENTORY - SIMPLIFIED!

The National Association of Insurance Commissioners has created a handy FREE APP for your phone. It does not collect data (per website), but allows you to go room to room and take pictures/videos of your stuff as well as add bar codes (An Evacuation Learning Workshop in Breckenridge a few years ago also suggested pictures of bar codes if you can find them.)



1. Download Free App and get started.

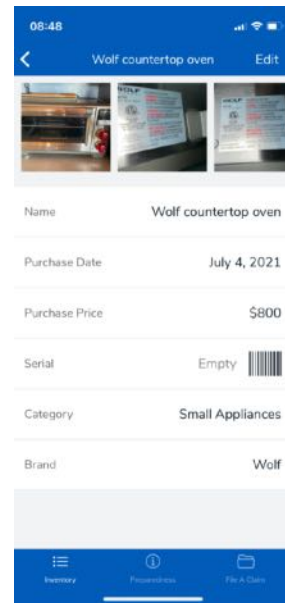
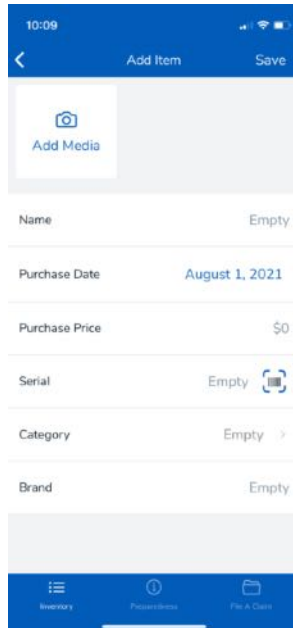
2. Choose the first room you want to document.
