

## **Disposal of Hazardous Materials**

Disposal of Hazardous Materials in the dumpsters at the Ranch is illegal and can lead to significant fines and cleanup costs. Such materials are described at the High Country website, [www.highcountryconservation.org](http://www.highcountryconservation.org)

The more common materials we encounter are listed below along with how to dispose of them.

**TV's, computer screens, computers, CPU's, all electronic devices** – take to the Dillon Dump. A modest cost will be incurred. The costs vary from \$8.00 for monitors, CPU's and laptops to \$13.00 for TV's under 26" and \$0.20/lb for TV's beyond 26" and large loads of electronics.

**Mercury containing thermometers and switches** – take to the Dillon Dump, no cost.

**Car Batteries** – trade them in or take them to the Frisco Recycling Center next to the State Patrol in Frisco. This is free. If you take them to the Dillon Dump you will be charged or told to take them to Frisco.

**All other batteries** – take to the Dillon Dump; no charge.

**Fluorescent light bulbs** – take to the Dillon Dump; 50 cents per bulb.

**CFL bulbs** – take to Bighorn Building Materials at the bottom of the ranch; no charge. Or, take to the Dillon Dump at 50 cents per bulb.

Any questions about this or other hazardous materials (e.g., paint), log onto the website noted above or call the Dillon Landfill at 468-9263 and hit 'O' to get the Operator or 15 to get Bonita Pfeiffer. The Dillon Landfill hours of operation are M-F 7:00 am – 4:00 pm with possible wind or lightening closures. The 4:00 pm means you need to be gone by then. To get to the Landfill/Dump take Hwy 6 East past the Swan Mountain Road intersection. Just as you arrive at the Keystone sign turn left on Landfill Road.
